

2019 Coyote Crossing Ladies 9 Hole Independent Golf League Rules

Reminder: All players must tee off from #1 tee box. When your group chooses to play, call ahead to schedule a tee time. Thank you!

1. The organization shall be known as the "Coyote Crossing Ladies 9 Hole Independent Golf League".
2. The objectives of the organization shall be to promote golf as a means of physical and healthful recreation for the women of the Lafayette area, to foster and promote a high standard of sportsmanship and spirit of competition, friendship and social enjoyment.
3. The officers shall be elected each year by the members and shall consist of President (who shall be banquet chairman), Secretary, and Treasurer (who shall be prize committee chairman).
4. Play will be at Coyote Crossing Golf Club on the front nine. The official day of play will be Tuesday. (for Scrambles)
5. Official U.S.G.A rules and winter rules will prevail. Winter rules mean the ball can be moved over or back a few inches in the fairway or rough. Check the back side of scorecards for club rules and special rules on attached page.
6. Play will begin April 22, 2019 and will continue for 19 more weeks.
7. The weekly handicap will be figured and posted.
8. Flights will be created July 15, 2019. Flights will be adjusted one additional time 2 weeks before the last week of play (August 19th) Once you are in a flight, you cannot change flights, but may move around in that flight.
9. Play will be Monday through Friday (must play with another league member) Cards will be collected on Saturdays. On the weeks of July 1st and Sept. 9th will be make up days for prior weeks missed (July 1st – 1st half) and (September 9th – 2nd half)
10. A \$45 membership fee must be paid to the Treasurer prior to playing the first nine holes of league play. Non-Members pay \$25 green fees weekly with cart.
11. A player must have at least 10 weeks of golf to be eligible for "League Standings" prizes.
12. At least two members must be in the group for the score to count as your official score. A dated and signed scorecard (by those members) is to be placed in the 9-hole score box located in the ladies locker room. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO INCLUDE THE DATE PLUS THE FIRST AND LAST NAMES ON THE SCORECARD.
13. KEEP TRACK OF YOUR PUTTS
14. A banquet will be held each year for the presentation of awards.
15. When the league exceeds 50 members, it shall be divided into at least four flights.

Last day of play is September 13, 2019.

Special League Rules

- Limit of 3 minutes to search for a lost ball.
- To speed up play, tee off in a foursomes if possible.
- For slower players, allow faster group to play through by moving to the side of the fairway and wave players through.
- Follow the 10 stroke rule

10 Stroke Rule – Important – Please read

If a player has taken 10 strokes and is NOT on the putting green, she should mark an “X” on her scorecard for that hole and pick up her ball. If a player has taken 10 strokes and IS on the putting green, she should putt out and mark her actual score on the scorecard. (This figure will exceed 10 strokes for that hole) Ten strokes is the most that the computer system will accept so even if you putt out and score over 10, you will be given a 10.

Hole #1 – (out of bounds) Left/Right of fairway – Drop at point of OB - 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #2 – Water left/right of green – drop 1 club length at point of entry
– 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #3 – High grass on the right side of fairway – drop 1 club length at point of entry – 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #5 – Creek (drop on green side near point of entry) – 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #6 – Left side of fairway (out of bounds) – drop 1 club length from point of entry
– 1 stroke penalty

Hole #7 – Creek (drop on green side in line of entry) – 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #8 – Creek (drop on green side in line of entry) – 1 stroke penalty.

Hole #9 – Creek across fairway, drop on green side in line of entry – 1 stroke penalty.

Pond on left, drop 1 club length at point of entry – 1 stroke penalty.
